

WINES OF THE MONTH

53. FIANO, CIACA BIANCO, SICILY, 2021

This organically produced wine was voted Best in Show and received a platinum medal at the Decanter wine awards this year – the world's largest wine competition with more than 18,000 entries. An aromatic white wine with fresh citrus flavours and a crisp long finish. Perfect with seafood pasta such as the fettucine crab, spaghetti marinara or the insalata di mare, suitable for vegans. Just 12.5% alcohol.

54. MALVASIA, IMPERATORI, 2020

This is made by a Frascati producer but from the malvasia grape variety which has been growing in the area for more than 600 years. A wonderfully pure wine with hints of dried fruit, almonds and white peach with a zesty finish. Perfect with richer shellfish dishes such as the lobster linguine, scallops or prawn tails. 13.5% alcohol.

55. MONTE VELHO BRANCO, ALENTEJO, 2019

One of Portugal's best-selling white wines in its homeland. Made from local grape varieties – antao vaz, perrum and roupeiro at the famed Esporao estate. The bouquet is of ripe white fruits leading to fresh citrus flavours and a crisp finish. An excellent aperitif and perfect match for the oysters, champignons Rochelle or crab salad. Capable of coping with white meat dishes too – veal particularly. 14% alcohol.

56. MONTEFALCO ROSSO, SCACCIADIIVOLI, 2018

Like Chianti? Then you'll love this. Made with a blend of sangiovese, sagrantino and a little merlot, it is a stunning wine with layered spicy fruit and a complex savoury finish. Think of it as a turbo-charged Chianti and you'll get an idea of what to expect. Just perfect with a simple steak such as the tagliata or rich meaty pasta dishes. 14.5% alcohol.

57. LAGREIN, BOTTEGA VINAI, 2017

Lagrein is the great red grape of Trentino in northern Italy. A warm spicy nose with lightly smoky aromas, mingle with plum, red berries and a hint of chocolate. The palate is finely structured with supple tannins and bright balancing acidity. Ripe plum and blackberry fruit lead to long, savoury finish with a typically Italian bitter cherry twist. Perfect at cutting through richly sauced dishes – the beef italiana or beef barolo would be ideal. 13% alcohol.

58. PINOT NOIR, ALPATACO, ARGENTINA

This is as pure as pinot noir gets. Fermented and aged in stainless steel to retain the purity of red fruits grown in the cool vineyards of Patagonia. It makes the perfect summer red and is ideal with the rack of lamb, veal or chicken breast spiedini or just if you prefer your reds on the lighter side. 13.5% alcohol.
