

## WINES OF THE MONTH

<b>53. GRECO/FIANO, PIPOLI, VULTURE 2020</b>	<b>£33.50</b>
Made from grapes grown in the volcanic soils of Mount Vulture in Basilicata. Greco and fiano are local grapes and produce a rich but dry wine with a tropical fruit nose and zesty lime flavours leading to a crisp fresh finish. The perfect wine with richer seafood dishes like the lobster linguine, scallop risotto, champignons Rochelle, or prawn tails gremolata. Good too with the veal dishes if you prefer white wine. 13% alcohol.	
<b>54. SOAVE CLASSICO, CAMPO DI TOVI, INAMA, 2020</b>	<b>£35.95</b>
This is soave at its most decadent. On the nose it has hints of wild flowers but once you sip the minerality of the soil takes over before finishing with Soave's classic almond finish. World class wine-making as usual from Stefano Inama. Try this with more delicate seafood dishes like the insalate di mare, fettucine with crab, or Dover sole. 12% alcohol.	
<b>55. VERDEJO, DIEZ SIGLOS, RUEDA, SPAIN 2020</b>	<b>£29.95</b>
If you like the flavours of sauvignon blanc but fancy trying something different then give this a go. Vibrant citrus fruit with zesty tropical fruit flavours and a bright fresh finish. Good aperitif but quite happy coping with spicy dishes so try it with the prawn tails gremolata, lobster linguine or the chicken spiedini. 13%	
<b>56. TUSCANTE GOVERNO, TUSCANY, 2020</b>	<b>£31.50</b>
This comes from Tuscany and uses Tuscan grape varieties but methods usually found up in the Veneto to make passimento valpolicella and amarone. Part of the wine is fermented normally and part uses partially dried grapes. This gives a richer wine with smooth ripe fruit. This is like a rich version of Chianti with spicy black berried fruit. Perfect steak wine – the tagliata would be ideal but good too with the rack of lamb or rich meaty pasta dishes. 13.5%	
<b>57. VALPOLICELLA RIPASSO, VILLA BORGHETTI, 2019</b>	<b>£33.95</b>
One of the purest pinot noir (nero) wines you will ever taste. Aged in stainless steel rather than oak, it is a bright, black-fruited, medium bodied wine that is a perfect match to white meats – try it with the chicken breast or paillard of veal for a perfect combination but good too with any of the veal dishes – or fish if you prefer red wine. Made with organically grown grapes. 14% alcohol	
<b>58. BROOKFIELDS BACK BLOCK SYRAH, HAWKES BAY, NEW ZEALAND, 2020</b>	<b>£43.95</b>
New Zealand is better known for its pinot noir but up in warm Hawkes Bay syrah flourishes. Shows dark plum and spiced cherry with almond characters and a rich silky finish. Founded in 1937, Brookfields is Hawkes Bay's oldest boutique winery and recent investment has transformed the quality here. Perfect with a simply grilled steak or even scallops in bacon if you prefer red wine. 13.5%
